Q: What is Ovation Fertility[™]?

Q: I read that Ovation bought Midwest Fertility Specialists? Is the practice no longer independent?

A: Ovation Fertility has purchased the laboratory at Midwest Fertility. Our team of reproductive endocrinologists remain an independent physician group and continue to practice independently from any health care system. Our physicians firmly believe in Ovation's science and philosophy and will work alongside the Ovation team; however, they do not work for Ovation.

Q: Is the staff changing?

A: The Midwest Fertility nursing team, physicians, support staff and lab technicians will remain intact. Our physicians will continue to see patients and perform procedures as they normally do at both our Carmel and Fort Wayne offices. Dr. Glen Adaniya, who has been with the practice for 20 years, will continue to lead laboratory services and operations with the additional guidance and support of the Ovation team.

Q: When does the partnership take effect?

A: The partnership is currently in effect.

Q: How will this impact any lab procedures I am scheduled for?

A: Our partnership with Ovation will not impact any lab procedures for patients.



Q: Will I be billed separately for lab services?

A: Yes. If you receive IVF/Andrology lab services, you will receive a separate bill for these charges. However, our business office will continue to handle all billing and can answer any questions you have about your statements.

A: Short-term storage for patients going through cycles in 2018 will not change. Midwest Fertility and Ovation are working together to ensure the safest long-term storage possible for patients in future cycles.
